Notes

The following are some reminders and helpful hints to keep in mind while riding the Plymouth and Brockton Street Railway Co.

ANIMALS—ADA service animals are the only animals allowed on P & B buses.

BAGGAGE—Baggage will not be checked on P&B Lines. All baggage will be transported in the baggage compartments. Small baggage may be placed in overhead racks in such a manner as not to endanger other passengers. No baggage will be placed in seats in any manner as to occupy space thus preventing a paying passenger from a seat. Baggage will be limited to 2 pieces per adult ticket and 1 piece per half fare ticket. \$5.00 will be charged for each additional bag. P & B IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR MISPLACED BAGGAGE, BUT WILL ENDEAVOR TO LOCATE SAME.

BICYCLES—Bicycles may be transported over routes of Plymouth & Brockton Street Railway Company, at owners risk at the prevailing tariff conditions. Bicycles may be carried in the baggage compartments when there is sufficient room after all other baggage and express has been loaded. Bicycles must be carried in a separate baggage compartment or placed in such a manner as not to damage any baggage or express in any way. There is no guarantee that bicycles will be accepted by connecting carriers.

CANCELLATION OF SERVICE—In the event that weather conditions warrant the cancellation of bus service, notice will be announced over the following stations: WPLM (Plymouth), 1390 kc WEEI (Boston) 850 kc, WRKO (BSN), 680 kc WBZ (Boston) 1030 kc, WATD (Marshfield) 96 FM, WCIB (Falmouth) 102 FM

CELLULAR PHONES—The use of cellular telephone devices is discouraged on all P&B busses with the exception of those situations where either a quick message or circumstances, beyond our control, delay the trip and passenger connections cannot be met. P&B requests that the use of cellular phones be limited with respect and courtesy to your fellow passengers.

CHILDREN'S FARES—Children, under 5 years of age, 2 only, not occupying seats to the exclusion of other paying passengers, will be carried free. Any additional children shall each pay a fare of one-half (1/2) of the one way fare. Children 5 years of age and under 12 years of age will be charged one-half (1/2) of the one way fare and must be accompanied by an adult (18 years of age or older) when riding coaches; otherwise they shall be charged full fare.

When PURCHASING a 1/2 fare ticket, the CHILDREN MUST BE IN COMPANY OF THE PURCHASER.

COMMUTER CHECK—Plymouth & Brockton participates in the Commuter Check Program. Check out our website (www.p-b.com) for detailed information.

CREDIT CARDS—Credit Card Sales unavailable from drivers. Please call for locations prior to travelling.

FARES—ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—Customers must have a ticket receipt in their possession at all times while riding P&B buses. In the event of disagreement with operator or ticket agent, please pay the fare he requests and communicate with the Plymouth office at 8 Industrial Park Rd., Plymouth, Massachusetts 02360.

FOOD & BEVERAGE—No open containers of food or beverage are allowed on coaches of this company.

HOVERBOARDS—Hoverboards are prohibited on all P&B property including stations and buses.

IN THIS TIMETABLE—We take every precaution to publish correct schedules. However, the times shown and connecting trips cannot be guaranteed. The company does not hold itself responsible for any errors, omissions or delays. All schedules shown herein are subject to change on fourteen (14) days notice.

LOGAN FARES—Override tickets to Logan Airport cannot be used in conjunction with the already discounted commuter tickets.

LOST ARTICLES—If you leave any personal article in a bus, report your loss to the nearest agent. Give full description of the article, the date of the loss, the point between which you traveled, and the time of day. We cannot, of course, be responsible for articles left in coaches or terminals, but we will make every effort to recover your property for you.

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS—This company reserves the right to refuse to transport a person under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or who is incapable of taking care of himself or herself, or whose conduct is such or likely to be such as to make him or her objectionable to other passengers or prospective passengers. Health Department regulations require that footwear be worn at all times by passengers.

PREPAID TICKETS—Tickets may be purchased at P&B terminals for passengers boarding at another P&B terminal location. A service charge of \$5.00 will be charged on all prepaid ticket orders. Prepaid tickets are non-refundable.

RADIOS—Radios or other sound equipment are permitted only when used with ear plugs so as not to inconvenience other passengers who may wish to relax or carry on quiet conversations.

REFUNDS—Tickets will be redeemed to Purchaser at the fare paid when no portion of the ticket has been used. Commutation tickets used in part are not redeemable. Tickets will be redeemed provided that they are presented prior to expiration date. Round trip discount does not apply to refund requests. A service charge of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) will be charged on all refunds made. Application for refund or tickets must be made in all cases to the general offices of this company at 8 Industrial Park Road, Plymouth, Massachusetts 02360.

SEAT OCCUPANCY—Seats are reserved for ticketed passengers only on a first come first serve basis. Passengers can only occupy one seat for travel and can not be utilized for luggage storage and/or extra seating space. Passengers requiring extra seating space must pay for each additional seat at full fare. P&B reserves the right, when operating conditions require, to transfer passengers from one vehicle to another en route.

SMOKING—No smoking permitted in Motor Coaches.

STEAMSHIP AUTHORITY—Tickets for the Steamship Authority boats can be purchased at P&B terminals in Hyannis, Plymouth, and the South Station.

STOPS—Please use designated bus stops at all times. Coaches of this company will load and unload passengers at designated stops only.

East Milton Stop—Northbound passengers will be discharged at "ABS" Computer Bldg., East Milton, upon request to driver. Passengers will not be transported between East Milton Sq. and Boston; Boston and East Milton. Northbound passengers will not be allowed to disembark at East Milton during the hours of day during which the high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane is open.

UNNECESSARY CONVERSATION—with the operator is prohibited.

WHEELCHAIR RESERVATIONS—Passengers requiring a wheelchair bus do not need to make reservations. Notifying P&B 24 hours in advance
